How to pay in your donation(s):

1. Paying in online:

A quick and simple way to transfer funds to us from your account is via our website. Go to actionforchildren.org.uk/donate and choose 'make a one-off donation'. Once you've entered how much you're donating, you can tell us it's from fundraising on the next page.

2. By bank transfer (BACS)

Please help us to track your funds by adding a reference to your payment. It might be the name of your church or postcode, or your Constituent ID, if you have it. Feel free to ask your Relationship Fundraising Executive for your ID, or contact Supporter Services. Please let them know you'll be making a payment in this way, so we can look out for it.

3. By phone:

Our Supporter Services Team can take your payment by card. Call them on **0300 123 2112**.

4. Paying in coinage:

Metro Bank has free coin deposit machines that anyone can use, even if you're not with Metro Bank. There is a 'Money Magic Machine' in every branch that will count your coins. You can print out a receipt that you can take to the counter to exchange for cash.

If you're a Barclays, HSBC, NatWest or RBS customer and have coins to deposit, you're in luck. All four banks offer free coin deposit machines in selected branches that will either pay the total straight into your account, or give you a voucher that you take to the counter to have the

total credited to your account. Check if your local branch has a machine first before taking your coins along.

You can also pay cash into your own account and then donate to us online.

5. Paying in by cash or cheque:

You can pay cash into our account using our details on this page (see point 2). You can do this in either a local HSBC branch, or by using an HSBC deposit card at your local Post Office®. Please contact our Supporter Services Team to have a deposit card sent to you.

You can deposit cheques to us by post (please note we can't receive cash by post).
